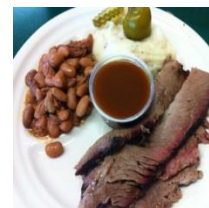
Please be praying for our youth as they prepare for LTC. Pray they have a safe trip & get great results at competition. They will leave April 3rd & return April 5th.
