

**The Greatest Commandment; Matthew 22:34-40**

I. Commandments

- A. Deuteronomy means “\_\_\_\_\_” and is a retelling of the events of Exodus, Leviticus, and Numbers - Deuteronomy 6:1–6
- B. Loving God with all our heart, soul, and mind necessitates \_\_\_\_\_; keeping His statutes and commands - Deuteronomy 6:6–9
- C. That is correct, but the greatest command is not that God \_\_\_\_\_, but that we love God
- D. John 14:15; 1 John 5:2–3

II. Our All

- E. God will not be \_\_\_\_\_ in our lives; He demands all our strength, all our heart, and all our mind

- E. God, through Jesus, gave us His all in the same form we are in, with the same \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, etc. - John 3:16
