The pantry item for this month is canned meats. We are in need of spam and canned chicken. Thank you for supporting this mission.

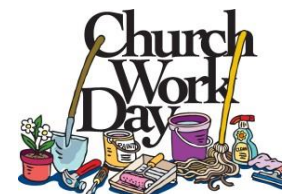
