

**I Am the Bread of Life; John 6:48-51**

- I. I Am
  - A. This is one of the most \_\_\_\_\_ phrases to an Israelite — Exodus 3:13–15
  - B. This is a definitive statement of God and His name that is “to be remembered throughout \_\_\_\_\_ generations”
  - C. \_\_\_\_\_ uses this phrase many times in the New Testament (even some that are hard to recognize) — John 6:48
- II. Moses
  - A. \_\_\_\_\_ in the wilderness — John 6:25-31; Exodus 16:31–36.
  - B. God gave them enough manna to feed 2.4 million people \_\_\_\_\_ (double the amount on the day of preparation so no one would have to pick up manna on the Sabbath)
  - C. \_\_\_\_\_ in the wilderness (Exodus 17:1-7) — John 6:32–35
- III. The Bread of Life
  - A. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ Himself with the manna that God gave them in the wilderness (Just like His is the living water and the rock from the wilderness) — 1 Corinthians 10:4
  - B. Jesus miracle with the \_\_\_\_\_ and the \_\_\_\_\_ preceded this in John 6:1-14
  - C. John 6:48–51
  - D. His earthly death will provide us a \_\_\_\_\_
  - E. We celebrate His sacrifice every \_\_\_\_\_
- IV. The Living Bread
  - A. Jesus admonishes the crowd for following Him because he \_\_\_\_\_ them fish and bread
  - B. Jesus wants them (us) to eat the \_\_\_\_\_ Bread
  - C. To proclaim Him as the great \_\_\_\_\_

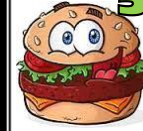
