Halfway through the field time and so much has happened! Between Vacation and the restart of classes life has been hectic; but I finally have time to sit down and write to you all about what has been going on here.

### **Vacation, New Happenings, and Restart of Classes!**

I was not able to go home for the holidays which was unfortunate, but I was invited to go to a friends house in Arizona and spend the Christmas and New Years with them. They financed the entire trip, which was fantastic, and I got there and back safely.

Due to the nature of San Antonio as a field, not having a car was swiftly becoming a hassle; between having bible studies, worship services, and service projects all over it was putting a toll on everyone. But God gaveme the opportunity to purchase a 1991 Ford Tempo, with less than 50,000 miles on it a an extremely reasonable

price. I did the math, pulled some strings, prayed a whole lot, and purchased it. It has made everything much easier, my roommate and I are able to go to the store without having to inconvenience someone and can get around much faster than we used to.

We also got new AIMers! One of the fields was shut down and three of the guys there wanted to continue in the program, so the directors sent them to us for the rest of their AIM time. Their names are: Jacob Couch, Holden (Westley) Hensley, and Luke Robinson. They will be joining us until August, which is when their field time ends.

Classes have started back up at the college, and with them comes a whole new batch of students; we have made several new friends and reunited with several old ones as well. We have started a video class on the book of Hebrews, taught by the late Gerald Paden, and have received some interest from the students on attending.

### **Campus Outreach**

Every other weekday we have been going out on to the campus and talking with anyone who will listen to us about the center and the things we do there. We haven't had too much success there but we have kept trying and will continue to do so, because if we stop advertising nothing at the center is going to grow. We have also been advertising a movie night every Friday evening at 6pm and have had a good turnout there, with several people coming and watching the movie and playing board games.

Grant and I have started playing card games with several people on campus, in the hopes that as we get to know them they will start to come to the center and attend bible studies. We have met several people this way and hope to continue meeting more and making new friends so that we can show Christ through our actions.

I have started a counseling ministry, at the recommendation of several people, and have been having a great turnout. I am currently counseling five people, three are Christians and two are not; I hope to work to change that in what I am doing. The goal of this ministry is to show people that they aren't alone in any fight, whether it be self harm, depression, low self esteem, or any other struggle they have. Even though it isn't limited to Christians I do use scripture as the basis for all of my meetings I have with them.

### **Campaign Time!**

Alamo City Church of Christ has a campaign every year right before and during spring break, where they pass out flyers all over San Antonio, advertising free Bible classes on the basics and the more advanced topics of scripture. We have handed out thousands of flyers so far and are going to continue doing it until the 17th of March. It is a huge campaign and they get tons of help from inside and outside, San Antonio. Please pray for us as we do this, pray that we will not be afraid to go up to people and invite them to learn more about Jesus.
