So when I got down here I didn't really know what to start doing. I had started working on getting an apartment and it had become a waiting game, between me and the offices of the ones I had looked at and was waiting to hear back from them. So in between that time I had the opportunity to work with the food bank that helps support the student center, and help the Church as well. Once the entire team got down here things began

in earnest. We went doorknocking for a campaign called "Crusade for Christ" It is a national campaign that has been going on for +30 years and is a really amazing experience! After the "Crusade" School began and the reason we were here became apparent.

The opening day of the campus here was crazy! There were about +5,000 students on campus and about a quarter of them came by the student center for free food and ice cream. We handed out free Bibles, offered Bible studies, and had a fun time playing pool and talking with the students. We do a free meal every Thursday, scheduled Bible studies every Monday and Wednesday, and unscheduled Bible studies whenever people want to. It has been extremely busy! There have been several students that have an interest in learning about the Bible and we have had a great success!

On the prayer side of things, the entire class will need all the prayers you can give them!
