How do you feel when you have been praying about something and it appears God's answer makes no sense to you? How do you handle it when you struggle to understand God's ways? Does it weaken your faith or to do you continue to cling to your faith while undergoing such struggles?

The prophet Habakkuk ministered during the last days of the nation of Judah. Initially, he struggles with understanding why God does not administer justice more quickly because of all the sinful people inhabiting the land: "O Lord, how long shall I cry, and You will not hear? Even cry out to You, 'Violence!' and You will not save. Why do You show me iniquity, and cause me to see trouble? For plundering and violence are before me; there is strife, and contention arises. Therefore, the law is powerless, and justice never goes forth. For the wicked surround the righteous; therefore, perverse judgment proceeds" (Habakkuk 1:2-4).

The book of Habakkuk is a powerful reminder to me that I must cling to my faith in God especially in times when His ways make no sense to me. I am constantly amazed at the ways in which God not only works His Will in the accounts I read about in the Bible, but also in the events in my own life. Today, I will strive to cling to my faith even during times when I do not understand all of God's ways.


